When a course is cancelled due to lack of numbers or unforeseen circumstances, course fees will be refunded in full.

If a participant withdraws five (5) working days prior to the commencement of the first class they will be entitled to a refund.

A \$20.00 administration fee is charged for withdrawals. There will be no refunds if you cancel after this time.
